Good Afternoon! Your child has indicated they would like to know more about school basketball. Please have a read through and contact me should you have any queries. Each team requires a minimum of 6 players, maximum of 8. The summer season is split over term's 1 and 4 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in the same grade in both term 1 and in term 4)

Who can play? Anyone from year 1 to year 7. Both girls and boys are welcome to play basketball for Brighton Primary School. There are options of mixed or single sex teams. Your response will help determine what teams we can offer.

Season Duration: The Basketball Mini Ball season runs weekly each term. Game start times vary from 3.45 – 6.30pm.

Game day and training: Monday - Year 6/7 Boys, Mixed & Girls; Tuesday - Year 4/5 Boys, Mixed & Girls; Wednesday - Year 2/3 & 3/4 Boys, Mixed & Girls; Thursday – Year 5/6 Mixed; Friday - Year 1/2 Mixed. Training is at the discretion and availability of your coach, the school hall and outdoor court. This will be communicated when teams are finalised. Please write your child's game night and team preference on the "Notes for Basketball Coordinator" section of the registration sheet. **Games Commence week starting Monday 11 February.**

Game location: Games are located at either Marion or Pasadena Stadium

Fees: \$5.00 payable on entry to each game, plus a \$25 registration fee payable to the school for the 2 terms.

Uniform: Basketball Singlet (on hire from the school), black shorts & sneakers. No jewellery to be worn including earrings. If the singlet is lost – you are required to pay a \$25 replacement fee.

Coaches and Team Managers: Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a coach (this can be shared between 2 people if preferred) and a team manager. Without these 2 positions filled for each team we will not be able to register the team.

For the safety of all our children, Brighton Primary School requires all coaches and team managers to have a current DCSI child related clearance. BPS initiate the application process for you and pays the fee of approximately \$58.00. This application is done online and takes approximately 10 minutes. If you are interested in putting your hand up to coach or team manage, please contact me (Jan-Marie) or call Sarah or Heather in the school's office to check on the validity of your current clearance, or to ask to get your application underway.

Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on court, and conducting practice. The coach will bring the team bag including game singlets & first aid kit to the games. Team Manager is responsible for communications. No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!

- * Ensure that the sport is appropriate for the age group and the skill development level of the players involved
- * Teach your players to be friendly towards officials and opponents.
- * Give all interested students a chance to participate in training and in games.
- * Remove from the field of play any of your players whose behaviour is not acceptable.
- * Keep your own knowledge of coaching and the developments of the game up to date.

FOR PARENTS:

- * Encourage participation by your children.
- * Provide a model of good sporting spirit for your child to copy.
- * Be courteous in your communication with players, team officials, game officials and sport administrators.
- * Encourage honest effort, skilled performance and team loyalty.
- * Make any new parents feel welcome on all occasions.
- * Do not interfere with the conduct of any events.

FOR SPECTATORS:

- * Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour.
- * Remember children play for enjoyment. Don't let your behaviour detract from their enjoyment.
- * Let game officials conduct events without interference.
- * Support skilled performances and team play with generous applause.
- * Demonstrate respect for opposing players and their supporters

Any perceived breach of the Code of Behaviour will follow the grievance policy available for your reference on the School Sports Policy.

Please liaise with your team coach or manager, and if not resolved, escalate to your sport's coordinator, the sports liaison coordinator, or to the Sports Committee Chairperson.
