Good Afternoon! Your child has indicated they would like to know more about school AFL. Please have a read through and contact me should you have any queries. The winter season is played weekly on Saturday's through both terms 3 and 4 (approx. 12 weeks in total).

Who can play? Anyone from year 2 to year 7. Both girls and boys are welcome to play AFL for Brighton Primary School. Your response will help determine what teams we can offer.

Season Duration: Term 2 and 3

Game day:

- Year 2/3 Saturday 08.30am (9 a side no tackling)
- □ Year 4/5 Saturday 09.30am (15 a side)
- □ Year 6/7 Saturday 10.30am (18 a side)

We anticipate games will commence in term 2, week 2

Training: Training is at the discretion and availability of your coach. This will be communicated when teams are finalised.

Game location: Games are located at either Brighton Primary School oval, or ovals of schools in the area.

Fees: \$65 for the season

Uniform: School AFL guernsey (on loan from the school), black shorts & football boots. No jewellery to be worn including earrings. If the guernsey is lost – you are required to pay a replacement fee of \$30.00.

Coaches and Team Managers: Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a coach (this can be shared between 2 people if preferred) and a team manager. Without these 2 positions filled for each team we will not be able to register the team.

For the safety of all our children, Brighton Primary School requires all coaches and team managers to have completed the Volunteers Pack. The 4 components of this are; DHS/DCSI Child related Clearance, RAN (responding to abuse and neglect) certificate, Volunteer application and site induction.

Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on field, and conducting practice. Team Manager is responsible for communications. The coach and team manager are responsible for duty of care for all players. No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!

- * Learn to value honest effort, skilled performance and improvement
- * Behave in a manner that respects the rights of others regardless of mediums of communication used,
- eg. Verbal and non verbal communication, digital mediums such as twitter, Facebook, email and texts

FOR TEACHERS, COACHES & TEAM MANAGERS:

- * Set a good example for your players.
- * Encourage and create opportunities.
- * Teach a wide range of team skills.
- * Ensure that the sport is appropriate for the age group and the skill development level of the players involved
- * Teach your players to be friendly towards officials and opponents.
- * Give all interested students a chance to participate in training and in games.
- * Remove from the field of play any of your players whose behaviour is not acceptable.
- * Keep your own knowledge of coaching and the developments of the game up to date.

FOR PARENTS:

- * Encourage participation by your children.
- * Provide a model of good sporting spirit for your child to copy.
- * Be courteous in your communication with players, team officials, game officials and sport administrators.
- * Encourage honest effort, skilled performance and team loyalty.
- * Make any new parents feel welcome on all occasions.
- * Do not interfere with the conduct of any events.

FOR SPECTATORS:

- * Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour.
- * Remember children play for enjoyment. Don't let your behaviour detract from their enjoyment.
- * Let game officials conduct events without interference.
- * Support skilled performances and team play with generous applause.
- * Demonstrate respect for opposing players and their supporters

Any perceived breach of the Code of Behaviour will follow the grievance policy available for your reference on the School Sports Policy.

Please liaise with your team coach or manager, and if not resolved, escalate to your sport's coordinator, the sports liaison coordinator, or to the Sports Committee Chairperson.
