Basketball

The summer season is split over term's 1 and 4 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in the same grade in both term 1 <u>and</u> in term 4). Your child must be prepared to play both terms 1 and 4. Should your child wish to withdraw; no refund will be provided.

Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches, children will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Game Venue	Marion Stadium, Norfolk Avenue, Marion or Pasadena Sports Centre, Corner of
	Goodwood Rd and Daws Rd Pasadena.
Training days	At the discretion of the coach and availability of the courts
Equipment	Provided by the school
Uniform	Black shorts, Basketball singlet hired as part of the fee. If singlet is lost or
	damaged a \$30 replacement fee is payable to the school. No jewellery or watches
	to be worn.
Fees	\$25 registration fee to be paid to the school (after invoiced) and \$6.00 / game fee
	payable to the stadium upon entry via card or cash. Spectators are free. Once
	invoiced, payment can be made via Qkr!, pay via Credit card or visit Lisa in
	Finance. Full payment is required by the due date, unless a payment plan has
	been established. Failure to pay by the due date will result in removal from the
	team.
Adult Support	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach and Team Manager.

**Coaches and Team Managers:** Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a coach (this can be shared between 2 people if preferred) and a team manager. Without these 2 positions filled for each team we will not register the team.

**Coaching** entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on court, and conducting practice. The coach is to bring the first aid kit to the games. The coach is responsible to take record of player attendance at training and games.

Team Manager is responsible for communications of game details, captains, scorer and venue. The team manager needs to take a team photo, and keep record of who is allocated which singlet, plus support the coach. No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!
Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the DECD Volunteer Application process.

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
