Cricket – Master Blaster

The summer season is split over term's 1 and 4 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in the same grade in both term 1 <u>and</u> in term 4). Your child must be prepared to play both terms 1 and 4. Should your child wish to withdraw; no refund will be provided.

Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches, children will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Adult Support	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach and Team Manager.

Coaches and Team Managers: Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a coach (this can be shared between 2 people if preferred) and a team manager. Without these 2 positions filled for each team we will not register the team.

Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on field, and conducting practice (if able). The coach is to bring the first aid kit to the games. The coach is required to take a record of attendance at training and games. **Team Manager** is responsible for communications of game details, captains, absences, etc. The team manager needs to take a team photo and provide support to the coach when needed.

No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!

Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the DECD Volunteer Application process.

A coordinator for cricket is needed. A coordinator is the contact person who allocates teams and communicates with coaches and SACA. Please contact Jan-Marie for more details or to volunteer. You will be supported.
