### Volleyball

The summer season is split over term's 1 and 4 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in the same grade in both term 1 and in term 4). Your child must be prepared to play both terms 1 and 4. Should your child wish to withdraw; no refund will be provided. **Late Registrations:** Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches/team managers, children will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

<b>Season dates</b>	Friday, 14 February – Friday, 3 April 2020. Term 4 dates to be advised.
<b>Game details</b>	Games are played for 30 minutes (Beach) 40 minutes (indoor)
<b>Team Size</b>	Minimum 5 players, Maximum 8 players
<b>Team Composition</b>	Teams are: Boys, Girls or Mixed.
<b>Game day and time</b>	Games will be played weekly on Friday's between 4.00 and 6.00pm
<b>Game Venue</b>	Brighton Secondary School - 305 Brighton Road - North Brighton, SA 5048
<b>Training days</b>	To be confirmed. Subject to hall and coach availability.
<b>Equipment</b>	Training equipment provided by our school. Game day provided by Volleyball SA.
<b>Uniform</b>	Black shorts or skort. Yellow extra curriculum top. School Cap or school hat for Beach. (Top and cap available at the uniform shop, cap cannot be worn to school)
<b>Fees</b>	Yr 6/7 players \$140 total. Yr 4/5 players \$130. Includes \$20 annual insurance requirement. Once invoiced by the school, payment can be made via Qkr! or pay via Credit card or visit Lisa in Finance. Full payment is required by the due date, unless a payment plan has been established. Failure to pay by the due date will result in removal from the team.
<b>Adult Support</b>	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach / Team Manager
<b>Additional Information</b>	<b>Spikezone Volleyball does not lead directly to Brighton Secondary School's Special Interest Volleyball (SIV) program.</b> Please familiarise yourself with the BSS SIV entry requirements (which focus on athleticism gained through many sports) on their <a href="#">website</a> . A boot camp for interested SIV applicants may be available if we have interest.

**Coaches and Team Managers:** Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a support person, either as a coach or team manager, to take on the role. Without this position filled for each team, we will not register the team.

**Coaching /Team Managing:** Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on court, and conducting practice (if able). The coach is required to take a record of attendance at training and games if no team manager. **Team Manager** is responsible for communications of game details, absences, and take a team photo. If your team does not have a coach, the Team Manager is responsible for taking the record of player attendance at games. No experience is necessary to support volleyball, many of us learn as we go! **Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the DECD Volunteer Application process.**

**A second coordinator for volleyball is needed. A coordinator is the contact person who allocates teams and communicates with coaches/team managers and Volleyball SA. Please contact Jan-Marie or Danielle for more details or to volunteer. You will be supported.**

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
