Tee ball

The summer season is split over term's 1 and 4 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in the same grade in both term 1 *and* in term 4). Your child must be prepared to play both terms 1 and 4. Should your child wish to withdraw; no refund will be provided.

Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches, children will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Years Available to play	Reception – Year 5
Season dates	Saturday, 13 February to Saturday 27 March. Term 4 dates to be advised.
Game details	Games are played for 50 minutes.
Team Size	Minimum 7 players, Maximum of 10
Team Composition	Teams are mixed – boys and girls
Game days	Saturday morning
Game time	Red Division – Reception - Yr 2 – 9.00am – 9.50am. Silver and Gold Division Yr 2* – Yr 5 10.00 – 10.50am (*if student has played previously and is comfortable being tagged, given out, and having strikes counted)
Game Venue	Glenelg Baseball Club – Anderson Ave, Glenelg North
Training days	At the discretion of the coach, generally before the game
Equipment	Provided by the school
Uniform	Black shorts, skort, leggings or tracksuit. Yellow extra curriculum top. Cap or school hat. (Cap and top available at the uniform shop, cap cannot be worn to school)
Fees	Registration is via the Qkr! app, no payment is required to register. \$40 registration fee to be paid to the school (after invoiced). Once invoiced, payment can be made via Qkr! or pay via Credit card or visit Lisa in Finance. Full payment is required by the due date, unless a payment plan has been established. Failure to pay by the due date will result in removal from the team.
Adult Support	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach and Team Manager.

Coaches and Team Managers: Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a coach (this can be shared between 2 people if preferred) and a team manager. Without these 2 positions filled for each team we will not register the team.

Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on field, and conducting practice. The coach is to bring the first aid kit and tee ball bag to the games.

Team Manager is responsible for communications of game details, captains, scorer and diamond. The team manager needs to take a team photo.

No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!

Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the DfE Volunteer Application process.

A coordinator for tee ball is needed for the red division teams. A coordinator is the contact person who allocates teams and communicates with coaches. Please contact Jan-Marie in the office for more details or to volunteer. You will be supported.
