The winter season is conducted during terms 2 and 3. Your child must be prepared to play both terms. Should your child withdraw; no refund will be provided.

Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are more players available, than teams or coaches, places will be made on first registered

<b>Years Available to play</b>	Year 2-7
<b>Season dates</b>	Term 2 – 7 rounds (8 May – 26 June, excludes June long weekend) Term 3 – 5 rounds (24 July – 21 August)
<b>Game details</b>	Yr 2: 4 x 10-minute quarters. Contact: No contact/bump. No contact or spoiling except accidental in nature Yr 3/4: 4 x 12-minute quarters. Contact: Modified tackle, No bump, pushing, knock or steal out of hands, or smother. Yr 5/6 and 7: 4 x 15-minute quarters. Contact: Tackling permitted as per Laws of Australian football.
<b>Team Size</b>	Yr 2 & Yr 3/4: 9 a side (3 zones) Maximum Squad 12. Yr 5/6 & Yr 7: 12 a side Maximum Squad 15.
<b>Team Composition</b>	Teams can be mixed, boys & girls.
<b>Game days</b>	Saturday
<b>Game time</b>	Yr 2-3: 08.30am Yr 4-5: 9.30am Yr 6/7: 10.30am
<b>Game venue</b>	Seaview High School
<b>Training days</b>	At the discretion and availability of the coach. May be before games.
<b>Equipment</b>	All game equipment provided by the school and SANFL
<b>Uniform</b>	Yellow and Black Football Guernsey on loan from school. Black shorts. Gold black hooped socks available through uniform shop or stores. Footy boots.
<b>Fees</b>	\$0.00 registration fee. \$110 total. \$20 to school and \$90 to be paid to SANFL registration <b>ONCE the teams have been confirmed</b>
<b>Adult Support</b>	<b>A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach, Team Manager + First Aid</b>

**Coaches and Team Managers:** Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a coach (this can be shared between 2 people if preferred) and a team manager. Without these 2 positions filled for each team we will not register the team.

**Coaching** entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on court, and conducting practice if able. The coach is to bring the first aid kit & resources to the games & practice and take register of team attendance.

**Team Manager** is responsible for communications of game details, captains, scorer and support the coach. The team manager needs to take a team photo.

No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!

**First Aid** each team needs a support person at each game with a Senior First Aid Certificate.

**Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the Department for Education Volunteer Application process.**
