Please register on Qkr! by Monday, 7th February 2022 at the latest

The summer season is split over term's 1 and 4 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in both term 1 and term 4). Your child must be prepared to play both terms. Should your child wish to withdraw; no refund will be provided.

Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches, children will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Years Available to play	Reception to Year 6
Season dates	Monday 21 February – Monday 11 April, 2022. Term 4 dates to be advised.
Game details	Games are played in 2 x 15-minute halves.
Team Size	Maximum 8 players, Minimum of 6
Team Composition	Foundation / Year 1 is a Mixed Competition only. Year 2 – 6 teams can be either all girls, all boys or mixed. Please indicate your preference on the registration form.
Game days	Monday: Year 5 & 6 (standard ring, size 6 ball), Tuesday: Year 3 & 4 (standard ring, size 5 ball), Wednesday: Year 2 & 3 (lower ring, size 5 ball), Friday: Foundation & Yr 1 (lower ring, size 5 ball, coach is allowed on court)
Game time	Varies each week – can be scheduled anywhere between 3:45 and 6.30pm start
Game Venue	Marion Stadium, Norfolk Avenue, Marion <u>or</u> Springbank Stadium, Corner of Goodwood Rd and Daws Rd, Pasadena.
Training days	At the discretion of the coach and availability of the courts.
Equipment	Provided by the school
Uniform	Black shorts, Basketball singlet hired as part of the fee. If singlet is lost or damaged a \$30 replacement fee is payable to the school. No jewellery or watches to be worn.
Fees	Registration is via the Qkr app , no payment is required to register. Summer Fee of \$110 per player includes entry to all games once invoiced . Spectators are free. Once invoiced, payment can be made via Qkr!, pay via Credit card or visit Finance. Full payment is required by the due date, unless a payment plan has been established. Failure to pay by the due date will result in removal from the team.
Adult Support	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach and Team Manager who have completed all Volunteer requirements.

Coaches and Team Managers: Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. **Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the Department for Education (DfE) Volunteer Application process, please refer to the blog for more details.**

Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on court, and conducting practice. The coach is to bring the first aid kit to the games. The coach is responsible to take record of player attendance at training and games.

Team Manager is responsible for communications of game details, captains, scorer and venue. The team manager needs to take a team photo, and keep record of who is allocated which singlet, plus support the coach. No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!
