Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches, children will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Equipment	Provided by the school
Uniform	Black shorts and school sports top. The new school sports tops are compulsory and
	can be purchased via QKR at a cost of \$30-00. No jewellery, or watches to be worn.
Fees	Registration is via the Qkr app, no payment is required to register. Summer
	Fee of \$125.00 per player includes entry to all games, equipment and
	administration once invoiced. Spectators are free. Once invoiced, payment can
	be made via Qkr!, or pay via Credit card. Full payment is required by the due
	date, unless a payment plan has been established. Failure to pay by the due
	date will result in removal from the team.
Adult Support	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach and Team Manager who have
	completed all Volunteer requirements.

Coaches and Team Managers: Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the Department for Education (DfE) Volunteer Application process, please refer to the blog for more details.

Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on court, and conducting practice. The coach is to bring the first aid kit to the games. The coach is responsible to take record of player attendance at training and games.

Team Manager is responsible for communications of game details, captains, and scorer and to support the Coach. No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!
