The summer season is split over terms 1 and 4 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in the same grade in both term 1 <u>and</u> term 4). Your child must be prepared to play both terms 1 and 4. Should your child withdraw; no refund will be provided.

Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches, children will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Fees	A and B Grade \$75.00 (Equipment and Administration). Registration is via the QKR
	app, no payment is required to register. Full payment is required by the invoiced
	due date given by BPS* (*unless a payment plan has been established). Failure to
	pay by the due date will result in removal from the team.
Adult Support	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach and Team Manager.

Coaches and Team Managers: Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the Department for Education (DfE) Volunteer Application process, please refer to the blog for more details.

Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on field, and conducting practice (if able). The coach is to bring the first aid kit to the games. The coach is responsible to take record of player attendance at training and games.

Team Manager is responsible for communications of game details, captains, scorer and support the coach. No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!
