

WINTER BASKETBALL 2023.

WINTER = TERMS 2 & 3. Qkr! Registration due by 9am Monday 27th March 2023.

The winter season is split over term's 2 and 3 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in both term 2 and in term 3). Your child must be prepared to play both terms. Should your child wish to withdraw; no refund will be provided.

Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches, children will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Uniform	Black shorts and the school sports top .The new school sports top is compulsory				
	and can be purchased via QKR at a cost of \$30-00. No jewellery or watches to be				
	worn.				
Fees	Registration is via the QKR app , no payment is required to register. Fee for 2				
	terms will be \$125.00. This includes registration of the team, stadium entrance				
	fee, participation medal, equipment and administration. Spectators are free.				
	Once invoiced, payment can be made via QKR! or pay via Credit card or visit Lisa				
	in Finance. Full payment is required by the due date, unless a payment plan has				
	been established. Failure to pay by the due date will result in your child not				
	playing in the team. Families will need to register their child by using the				
	BASKETBALL CONNECT app. Further details will be emailed once teams have				
	been arranged.				
Adult Support	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach and Team Manager.

Coaches and Team Managers: Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a coach (this can be shared between 2 people if preferred) and a team manager. Without these 2 positions filled for each team we will not register the team.

Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on court, and conducting practice. The coach is to bring the first aid kit to the games. The coach is responsible to take record of player attendance at training and games.


Team Manager is responsible for communications of game details, captains, and scorer to support the coach. No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!
