The winter season for netball is conducted over terms 2 and 3. Your child is required to play both terms. Should your child withdraw; no refund will be provided.

Please be aware that year 2's will play in an Yr2/3 competition

Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are more children registered, than teams and coaches available, children will be accepted on a first registered, first placed basis.

Years Available to play	Year 2 – 6
Season dates	Season is for Term 2 & 3. First game is Week 2 term until week 9. Continues Term 3 Week 2 until week 8.
Game details	Yr. 2-4: 4 x 10-minute quarters. Ring height 2.44m (may be full height for Yr. 4 if other courts are being used) Played in 2 levels: Yr. 2/3 Comp and Yr. 4 Comp Yr. 4-6: 4 x 12 minute quarters. Ring height standard 3.05m. Played in Division 1-3
Team Size	7 players on a court. Maximum Squad 9.
Team Composition	Girls and boys
Game days	Yr. 2-4: Thursday afternoon Yr. 4-6 Wednesday afternoon.
Game time	4.00pm start
Game venue	Brighton Primary courts and other local schools. Home and away fixture.
Training days	At the discretion and availability of the coach. May be before games.
Equipment	All game equipment provided by the school
Uniform	The new school sports top, black shorts, skirt or skort. The sport's top is compulsory and can be purchased from Belgrave Apparel. The tops cost \$42-00. No jewellery -including no tape over earrings. Nails cut short, cannot be seen over fingertips.
Fees	Registration is via the QKR app , and payment is required when registering. Please contact Lisa (Business Manager) to arrange a payment plan if needed. Netball season fee of \$90-00 per player includes registration per team, umpire costs, equipment, participation medal and administration. Coaches will receive free payment for netball. When registering you will need to pay the full amount of \$90-00 and the school will put a credit against the school fees for this amount.
Adult Support	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach and Team Manager

Coaches and Team Managers: Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a coach (this can be shared between 2 people if preferred) and a team manager. Without these 2 positions filled for each team we will not register the team.

Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on court, and conducting practice if able. The coach is to bring the first aid kit & resources to the games & practice and take register of team attendance.

Team Manager is responsible for communications of game details, captains, scorer and support the coach. No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!

Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the Department for Education Volunteer Application process. These school volunteer packs can be collected from the school office.
