WINTER = TERMS 2 & 3. Qkr! Registration due by 9am Tuesday 2nd April, 2024.

The winter season is split over term's 2 and 3 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in both term 2 <u>and</u> in term 3). Your child must be prepared to play both terms. Should your child wish to withdraw; no refund will be provided.

Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches, children will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Game Venue	Marion Stadium, Norfolk Avenue, Marion, Pasadena Sports Centre, Corner of Goodwood Rd and Daws Rd Pasadena, Cosgrove Hall, Mitchell Park or State Basketball Centre, Rose Terrace, Wayville.
Training days	At the discretion of the coach and availability of the courts
Equipment	Provided by the school
Uniform	Black shorts and the school sports top .The new school sports top is compulsory and can be purchased from Belgrave Apparel. The tops cost \$42-00. No jewellery or watches to be worn.
Fees	Registration is via the QKR app, and payment is required when registering. Please contact Lisa (Business Manager) to arrange a payment plan if needed. Winter season fee of \$125-00 per player includes entry to all games, equipment, participation medal and administration. Spectators are free. Coaches will receive free payment for basketball. When registering you will need to pay the full amount of \$125-00 and the school will put a credit against the school fees for this amount. Families will need to register their child with Basketball SA even if you played in Term 1. The MSBL Link details will be emailed once teams have been arranged.
Adult Support	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach and Team Manager.

Coaches and Team Managers: Brighton Primary School extra-curricular sports are run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the Department for Education Volunteer Application process, please refer to the school website or collect a volunteer pack from the school office.

Coaching entails teaching the players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on court, and conducting practice if possible. The coach is responsible to take record of player attendance at training and games and bring the equipment to the game.

Team Manager is responsible for communications of game details, captains, scorer and to support the coach. No experience is necessary for either position, many of us learn as we go!
